WILDFIRES EMERGENCY CONTACTS, UPDATE & TIPS

The fires as of Monday July 10, 11am are far off at this time, we aren't in imminent danger. Skeetchestn Natural Resources Corp. has crews actually visually monitoring the fires. We will know if trouble is coming well in advance and will be able to communicate to you for a smooth evacuation if needed.

In the meantime, read the Evacuee tips that the Fort McMurray evacuees have put together on facebook.

What you can do today: you should be sure to prepare a grab-and-go kits for each family member, with **medications, important papers, identification, or any other important documents**.

We have attached the emergency contact listing for you in the event there is a Community Emergency.

In case of evacuation

The main evacuation route will be down the Deadman Vidette Road, with the marshalling point being the Skeetchestn Public Works Shop (250-373-0164).

All members who are evacuated must register at the **Reception Centre** located at TRU, this will ensure that you receive support for 72 hours under the assigned Task Number for our area. **Skeetchestn members and community members will not be covered unless they register at the reception centre.**

We are monitoring the wildfire activities within our area, with Emergency Management BC. We had a Council and management meeting this morning and will continue to attend the conference call meetings throughout the day and evenings.
