



# Skeetchestn Report

## Card Policy

Effective August 28, 2018

Registered Skeetchestn band members who are on and off reserve and all other status individuals residing on Skeetchestn Indian Band reserve may bring in their report cards to the Education Coordinator to receive an incentive for good grade and attendance. Those status individuals not registered with Skeetchestn will have to provide a letter from their Band indicating they do not receive report card incentives or any other type of monetary funds before Skeetchestn will consider assisting in any way


- Students in Kindergarten to grade 3 will receive a gift card at the end of the year if advancing to the next grade.
- Students in grades 4 to 7 will receive a check each term for their grades and attendance at the end of each term according to the grids to follow.
- Students in grades 8 to 12 will receive a check for their grades and attendance at the end of each term according to the grids to follow.
- Off Reserve students will be first come, first serve basis due to changing budgets each year from the Royal Trust Fund money. On-Reserve students money will come from the Education budget.





# Secondary School

## Achievement

Every letter grade for each term is given a value listed below to find the GPA of the student. Add all the values together and divide how many classes taken gives you the GPA.

<u>Letter Grade</u>	<u>Value</u>
A	5
B	4
C+	3
C	2
C-	1
D/E/F/I/DNC	0

Once you have the GPA look to the table below and find the Money Value to the GPA.

<u>Average</u>	<u>Money Value</u>
4.5 to 5.0 GPA	\$75
3.5 to 4.4 GPA	\$60
2.5 to 3.4 GPA	\$45
1.5 to 2.4 GPA	\$30
0.5 to 1.4 GPA	\$15
0.0 to 0.4 GPA	\$0

## Attendance

The days missed throughout the term should be added together and divided by the total number of school days.

Example:

$$\begin{array}{r} 41 \text{ days of school} \\ - \text{ 7.5 days missed} \\ \hline 33.5 \text{ days attended} \\ \div 41 \text{ school days} \\ \hline 0.817 \\ \times 100 \% \\ \hline \mathbf{81.7\%} \text{ school days attended} \end{array}$$

This student would then receive **\$20** for attendance.

Days attending % of Total	Money Value
95-100%	\$50
90-94%	\$40
85-89%	\$30
80-84%	\$20
75-79%	\$10
Less than 75%	\$0

# Elementary School Grade 4-7

Every letter grade for each term is given a value listed below to find the GPA of the student. Add all the values together and divide how many classes taken gives you the GPA.

<u>Letter Grade</u>	<u>Value</u>
A	5
B	4
C+	3

<u>Average</u>	<u>Money Value</u>
4.5 to 5.0 GPA	\$37.50
3.5 to 4.4 GPA	\$30
2.5 to 3.4 GPA	\$22.50
1.5 to 2.4 GPA	\$15
0.5 to 1.4 GPA	\$7.50
0.0 to 0.4 GPA	\$0

## Attendance

The days missed throughout the term should be added together and divided by the total number of school days.

Example:

$$\begin{array}{r} 41 \text{ days of school} \\ - \text{ 7.5 days missed} \\ \hline 33.5 \text{ days attended} \\ \div 41 \text{ school days} \\ \hline 0.817 \\ \times 100 \% \\ \hline \mathbf{81.7\%} \text{ school days attended} \end{array}$$

This student would then receive **\$10** for attendance.

Days attending % of Total	Money Value
95-100%	\$25
90-94%	\$20
85-89%	\$15
80-84%	\$10
75-79%	\$5
Less than 75%	\$0

## Elementary Students Grades K-3

If students between Kindergartens to grade 3 pass to the next grade they will receive a \$50 gift card.
